It gives me great pleasure to inform you that the following property:

Ravenna-Cowen North Historic District

roughly bounded by 65th St. to the north, Ravenna Park to the south,
the Ravenna Ravine to the east, and 12th Ave to the west, Seattle

has been listed in the National Register of Historic Places, where it joins other districts which contribute to the rich cultural heritage of Washington State. The district is historically significant as an area that relates directly to the broad patterns of residential growth and development in the city of Seattle following the turn-of-the-century. Additionally the district is significant for its collection of homes which embody the distinctive characteristics of homes from the early to mid 20th century; many of which represent the work of noted architects and/or master builders.

The National Register records the tangible reminders of the history of the United States and is the official repository for documentation of cultural resources worthy of preservation.
